The Asian Development Education Workshop

The Development Education Workshop is an intensive personal motivation and awareness raising process that begins with the participation in a five days residential workshop conducted by the Association of Asian Confederation of Credit Unions in partnership with two Australian credit union organization: Credit Union Foundation Australia and WAW Credit Union.

The Asian Development Education Program started in 1999. ACCU, after attending the Australian DE Program has generated a tremendous motivation and obligation to replicate the Australian DEP course in Asia. CUFA has supported and

will continue to support this endeavor to multiply the impact to as many Asian credit unions as possible. WAW Credit Union supports the Asian DEP believing that it is an excellent vehicle to promote the values associated with credit unions worldwide. From 1999, 192 DEs from Bangladesh, Hong Kong, Malaysia, Nepal, Indonesia, Singapore, Philippines, Taiwan, Sri Lanka, Korea and Thailand graduated from Asian DEP and more than 50 DE graduates from Australia. They have performed extremely well in their presentations, developed self-confidence, widened understanding of global credit union system and issues.

-  Have the time available to make use of opportunities to promote the movement's values when occasion arise;
-  Good in spoken and written English;
-  Submit an application on the form provided (back side) meeting all the criteria and pre-selection requirements.
